I do hereby state that I pay or supervise the payment of the persons employed by me on this contract and that during this payroll period all persons employed on this contract have been paid the full weekly wages earned, that no rebates have been or will be made either directly or indirectly to or on behalf of myself or my subcontractor from the full weekly wages earned by any person and that no deductions have been made either directly or indirectly from the full wages earned by any person, other than permissible deductions as defined in Regulations, Part 3 (29 CFR Subtitle A), Issued by the Secretary of Labor under the Copeland Act, as amended (48 Stat. 948, 63 Stat. 967;76 Stat. 357;40 U.S.C. 276c), and described below:

Deductions are based on gross wages and include but are not limited to: Federal Withholding, FICA, Medicare, State Withholding, State Disability Insurance, Union Deductions, Child Support or Other Garnishments. Explanations for deductions listed in the "Other" Column are described on the Certified Payroll Report.

That any payrolls otherwise under this contract required to be submitted for the above period are correct and complete; that the wage rates for laborers and mechanics contained therein are not less than the applicable wage rates contained in any wage determination incorporated into the contract; that the classifications set forth therein for each laborer or mechanic conform with the work he performed.

That any apprentices employed in the above period are duly registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the State apprenticeship agency recognized by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, United States Department of Labor.

That where fringe benefits are paid to approved plans, funds or programs, in addition to the basic hourly wage rates paid to each laborer or mechanic listed in the above referenced payroll, payments of fringe benefits as listed. Where fringe benefits are paid in cash, each laborer or mechanic listed in the above reference payroll has been paid, as indicated on the payroll, an amount not less than the sum of the applicable basic hourly wage rate plus the amount of the required fringe benefits as listed in the contract.
